Our Mission

The Amit Early Intervention Program is dedicated to providing quality programs and coordinated services to children, ages birth to seven, and their families. Research has shown that early identification of developmental delays in young children, followed by direct and appropriate intervention during the critical early years, leads to a greater success in academic and social development.

With this focus, The Amit Early Intervention Program is designed to be:

Developmentally Focused

Helping children to acquire and expand their age-appropriate fine and gross motor skills, self-help skills, and communication skills.

Family Devoted

Creating a partnership to provide support and guidance for the entire family to help reduce the feelings of stress and frustration.

Child Centered

Coordinating services to assess and treat the whole child in a nurturing, caring, and professional environment.

Programs and Services

The Amit Early Intervention program offers the following programs and services to young children and their families in the Atlanta community.

- Parent education, consultation, information, and referral
- Occupational and speech therapy screenings and evaluations on-site, at the Amit office, or at a pre-arranged location
- Services scheduled within two weeks of initial contact
- Ongoing occupational and speech therapy
- Physical therapy and psychological testing and support services as needed
- Facilitator training and placement
- Follow-up reports within two weeks
- Monthly speaker series addressing educational topics
- Online virtual support group for parents to interact and learn from each other
- Ongoing professional development courses for teachers, parents, and professionals
- Individualized special education program through the Amit Gar'inim School
